People who Inject Drugs, 2013

- ✘ Harm reduction program (Needle Syringe Exchange and OST program) are key interventions among people who inject drugs in Nepal.
- ✘ NAMUNA and Save the Children supported NGOs are implementing harm reduction services with the support from government of Nepal and its pool partners and the Global Fund.

- ✘ The priority targeted prevention intervention among MSM and TG are behavior change interventions, including provision of condoms and lubricants, HIV testing and counseling, diagnosis and treatment of STIs and referral services.
- ✘ The Blue Diamond Society is implementing the interventions with the support from government of Nepal and its pool partners and the Global Fund.

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Migrants and their Spouses, 2013

- ⚡ Male labor migrants (particularly to India) and clients of FSWs in Nepal acts as bridging populations for HIV transmission to general and other risk population. Spouse of migrants and their children are equally at higher risk for acquiring HIV.
- ⚡ The priority targeted prevention intervention among migrants and their spouses are behavior change interventions, including provision of condoms, HIV testing and counseling, diagnosis and treatment of STIs and referral services.
- ⚡ The Government and its partners, FPAN, Save the Children, CARE and Saath-Saath Project are implementing agencies through NGOs among migrants and their spouses.

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Female Sex Workers and their Clients, 2013

- ✘ Clients of female sex worker are the bridging population for HIV transmission into general population.
- ✘ The Government and its partners, Saath-Saath Project and Save the Children are implementing intentions through NGOs among migrants and their spouses.
