**National AIDS Policy, 1995**

National policy on HIV/AIDS was adopted in Nepal in 1995, which ensure the high priority of HMGN to prevent HIV and AIDS.

1. Government will give high priority to HIV/AIDS and STDs prevention programmed.
2. HIV/AIDS and STDs prevention activities will be conducted as multisectoral programme.
3. HIV/AIDS and STDs prevention activities will be implemented on the basis of decentralization at the village district and regional level.
4. HIV/AIDS and STDs prevention activities will be implemented through government and non-governmental sectors.
5. HIV/AIDS and STDs prevention activities will be integrated with other programme in both the governmental and non-governmental sectors.
6. HIV/AIDS and STDs prevention activities will be coordinated, followed up and evaluated in both government and non-governmental sectors.
7. Safer sexual behaviour will be promoted.
8. Counseling and other services will be provided to people living with HIV/AIDS.
9. Discrimination on the basis of HIV/AIDS status will be discouraged.
10. All results of blood test for HIV/AIDS and STDs will be kept confidential.
11. Reports of blood test will be made available to National Centre for AIDS and STD Control.
12. All donated blood will be screened before transfusion.
